Training Programs

Full Training - \$650 plus board

Includes 5 training rides and/or lessons per week (total of 20 per month), grooming for training rides, and management of SmartPak, grain, vet, farrier, body work and chiropractic. Additional grooming to maintain show-ready appearance (muzzle, ear clip, mane pull, etc) is at an additional charge to owner.

All training clients are required to attend, minimally, 2 rated shows or 2 schooling and 1 rated show per season. Full Training - \$650 plus board

Full Training Horse Only- \$750 plus board

Includes 5 training rides per week (total of 20 per month), grooming for training rides, and management of SmartPak, grain, vet, farrier, body work and chiropractic. Additional grooming to maintain show-ready appearance (muzzle, ear clip, mane pull, etc) is at an additional charge to owner.

Leasing a TBS Horse

Partial Lease - price varies depending on horse (~\$1250-\$1550)

Includes half of training (two lessons, one scheduled 30 min hack, training rides as needed), board, horse care, grooming for training rides, supplements, and management of vet, farrier, grain and feed.

All partial lease holders will be required to attend, minimally, 1 rated show or 2 schooling shows per season. If you start a lease at the end of a show season, it is expected that the lease will continue until fulfilled in the next show season.

Trial Package

All our new riders start with a 30 day evaluation period to assess your riding level and ensure TBS is the right fit for your riding goals. After 30 days we will talk one-on-one to discuss program options and create a plan to reach your goals.

Crossrail and Below Riders :\$400 - 4 lessons (1x/week)

2'+ Riders: \$800 - 8 lessons (2x/week)

Prices above includes use of TBS horse and equipment. With use of personal horse price adjusted to \$75/lesson with \$45 monthly trailer-in fee. Lessons may vary between private and semi-private. All trial package lessons must be completed within 30 day evaluation period or otherwise forfeited.

Saddle Lease Fee: \$50-\$75

Program Guidelines

Hacking Rules

- If you lease or own a horse, you may hack without a trainer present.
- There is absolutely **no jumping or flying changes** without being in a scheduled lesson.
- Clients under the age of 18 years old **MUST** have a parent or guardian present.
- Poles are not to be used while hacking.
- If you are on a lease horse, please limit your hack to 30 minutes.
- You **MUST** wear a helmet.
- Please **lock up** tack/equipment when done and put your horse away properly.



Scheduling Updates & Changes

GOOGLE FORM SUBMISSION

Every client wishing to take lessons must submit a response to the Google Form by the date designated by Triple Bar Stables to be put in the schedule for the coming month.

24-HOUR CANCELLATION POLICY

If a lesson is missed or a cancellation is attempted less than 24-hours before the lesson's scheduled time, the rider forfeits the lesson.

RESCHEDULING

Training/Leasing Clients

If you are in a training program or lease and have to cancel a lesson with less than 24 hours before your scheduled time, you will not be granted a makeup lesson as your horse will be exercised that day by a member of our staff. If you need to reschedule your lesson, you will be given up to three options to reschedule. If you cannot make those options, you forfeit the lesson. Training/Leases allow for the days to be interchangeable between training rides and lessons. All makeup lessons are required to be taken within the month they were originally scheduled. Partial leasing clients, please be aware rescheduling

will be done in consideration of shared leaser's originally scheduled lessons.

Trial Package Clients

Lessons requested to be rescheduled within the 24-hour cancellation period must be taken within the originally scheduled month. There are no rollover lessons. For example, if the lesson cannot be made up within the month, the rider forfeits the lesson. If the lesson is cancelled by TBS and it is not possible to reschedule within the month, the option to rollover will be discussed based on circumstances. We will give you up to three options for an exchange time. If you cannot make the options that work for our schedule, you forfeit the lesson.
